

The Janesville Housing & Redevelopment Authority (JHRA) was established in 1981 to meet the housing needs of low-income families, elderly and disabled residents of the City of Janesville and its surrounding area. We are a Public Housing facility and do not accept vouchers.

Units are leased on an income-based rental (30% of adjusted monthly income), or at a flat rental rate, depending upon what the resident chooses. To qualify, annual gross household income cannot exceed these amounts:

1 person - \$42,150

2 persons - \$48,150
